




HOW TO MEASURE YOUR WINDOWS - ROLLER BLINDS


For accuracy and perfect fit please measure in centimetres and / or millimetres with a steel tape measure. All blinds will be made as inside recess unless stated you want outside recess.

Measuring for inside the recess



Please measure the inside of the recess width and drop with no deductions, as we will deduct 10mm from the width, so it fits in the recess.

Measuring for outside the recess



Please decide the distance you require the blind to overlap the recess and send us the width and drop you require the blind to be, stating bracket to bracket size.

Measuring for fabric width

The fabric width is usually when measuring for doors.

Please send us the width you want the fabric stating this is fabric width.

Measuring bay windows and conservatories for roller blinds



When measuring a bay window please measure the full distance of A, B, C in photo above, then deduct 25mm from B and C only for the angle, the sizes you should now have are classed as inside recess sizes.

When measuring a rectangular bay window or conservatory always measure the front face first. This blind will be a recess fit. Then measure the width of one side and take off 65mm to allow for the front blind e.g. 1000mm total width minus 65mm for front blind = 935mm. The measurement will be a 935mm recess fit blind. Repeat this for other side.
